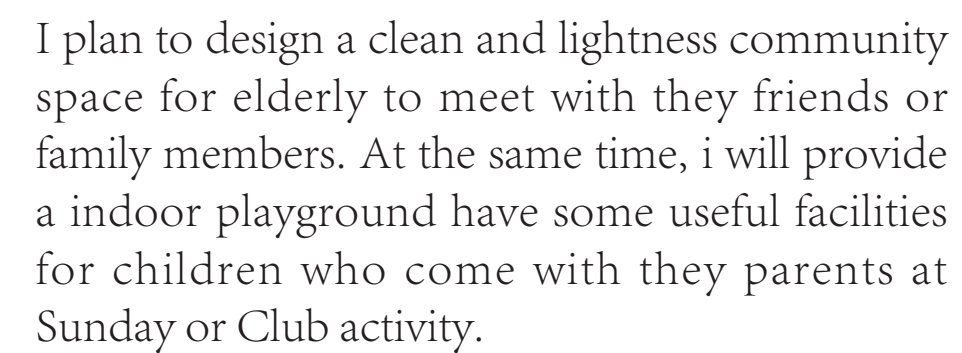
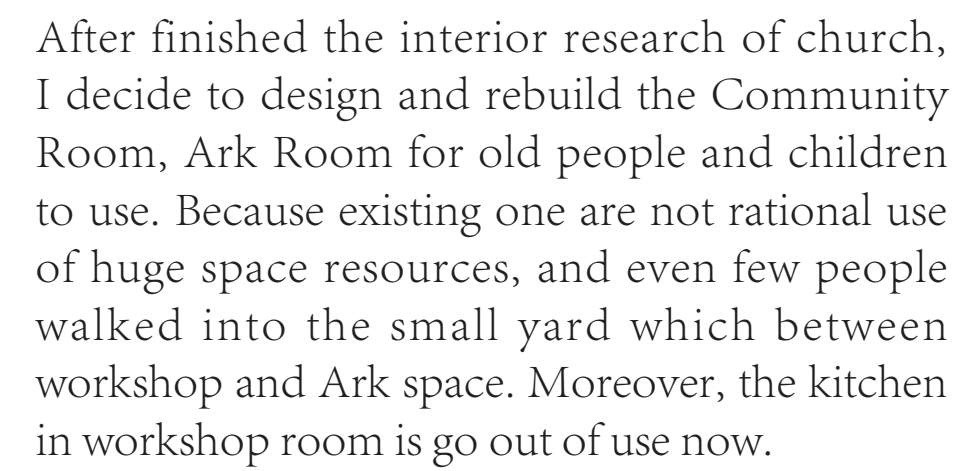


COMMUNITIES & ACTIVITY

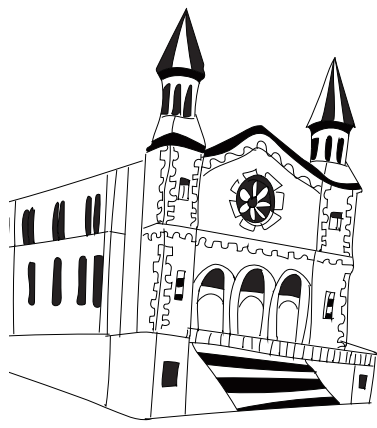

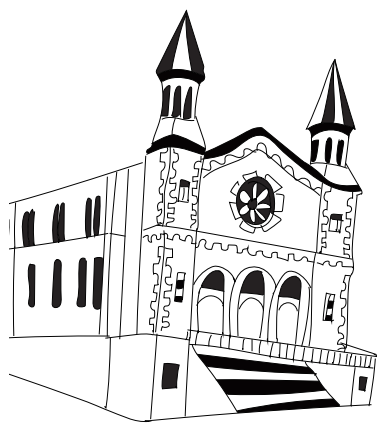

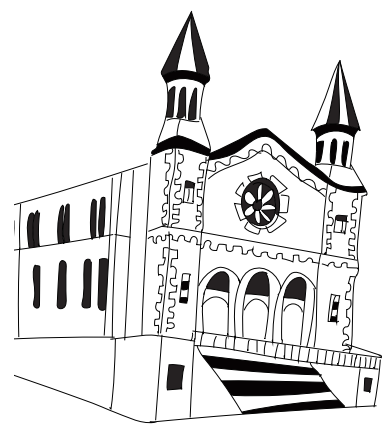
Thinking about Ark Room, which is associated with a story named Noah's Ark from the Old Testament. So I supposed the church building as the ship and all people will be protected in this place.



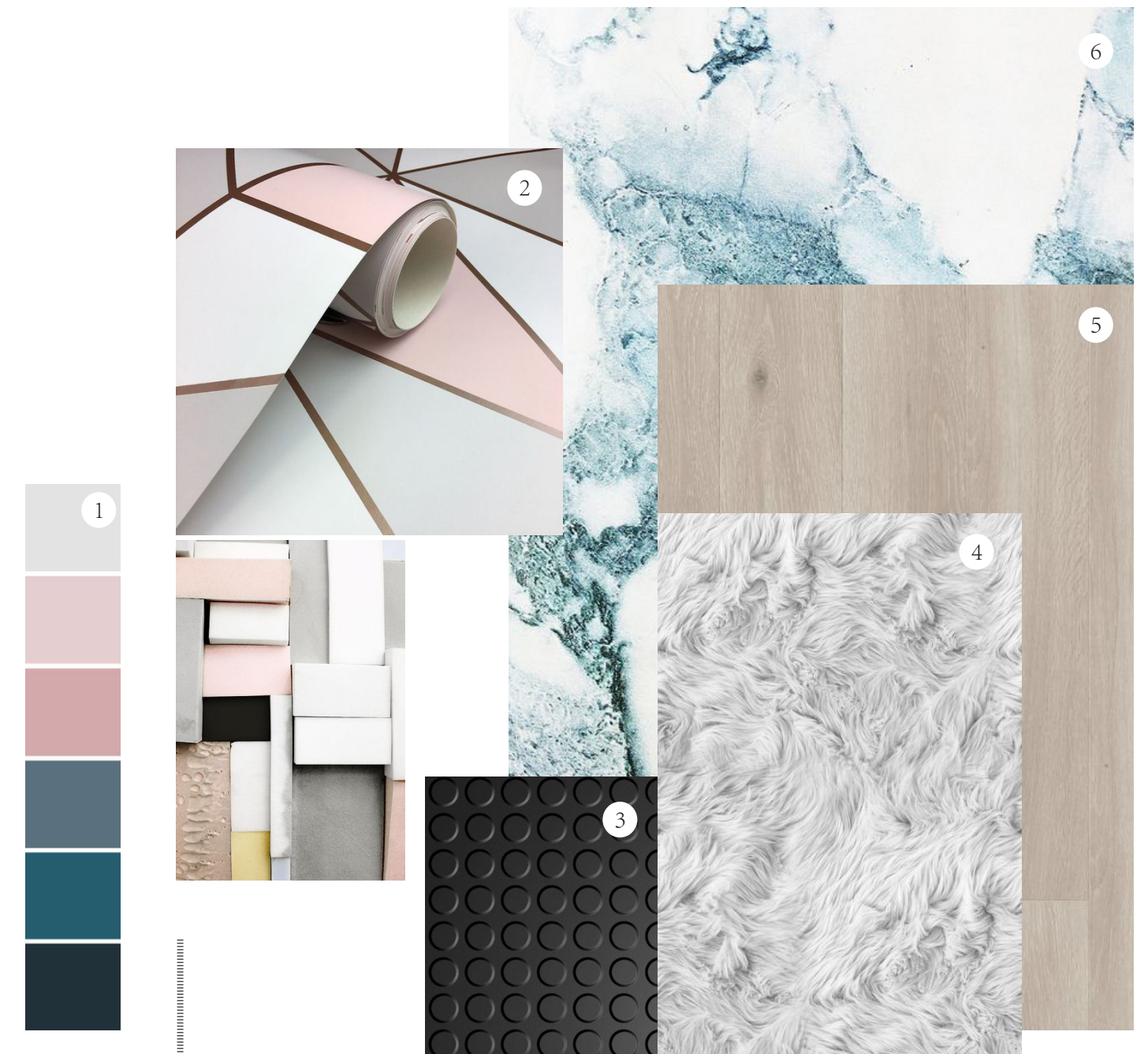
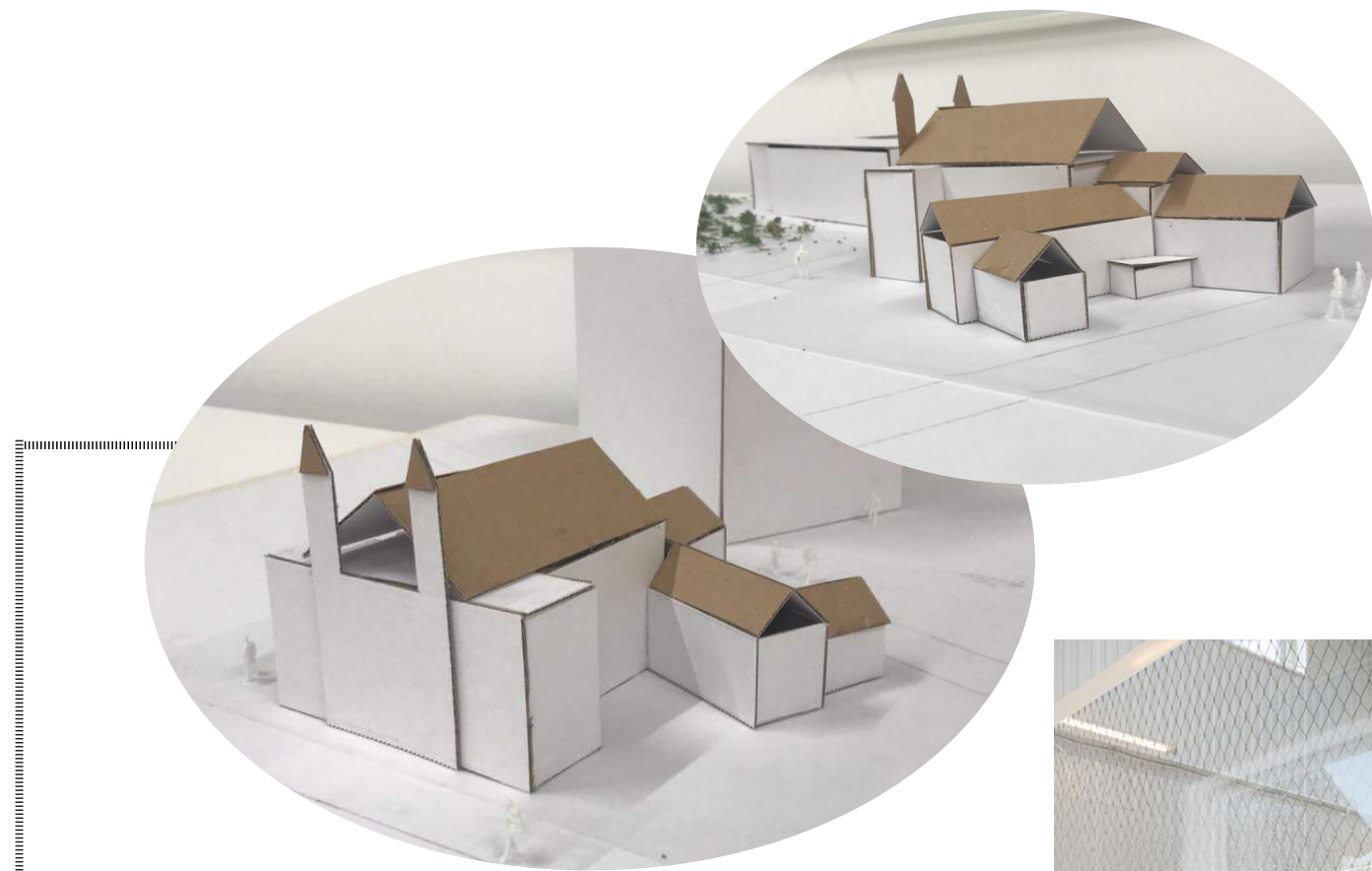


EXTERNAL FACADE OF THE BUILDING



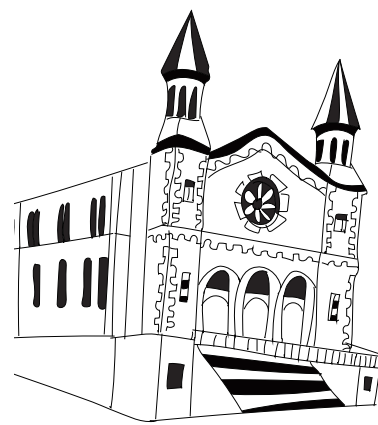

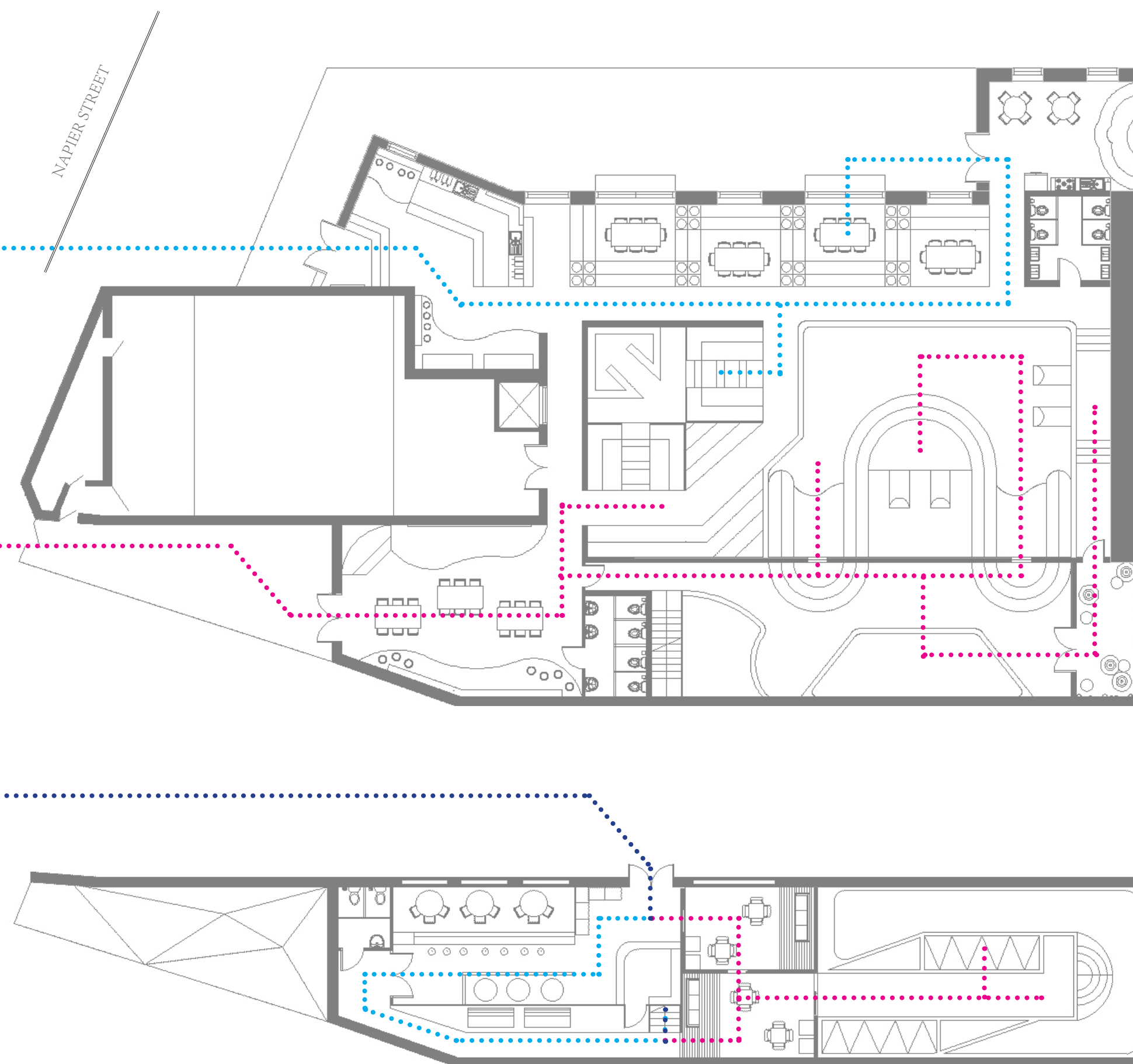


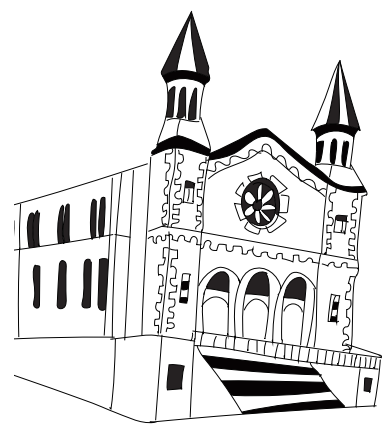
ROUTE DIAGRAM

In my ground floor design, elderly and young adult can enter this building from the gate which close the Napier Street. There have a cafe counter in front of door so people can order your drink and take to LEGO seating area with your group friends. If you are alone and want to chat with someone can just seat at right side, there are some bar tables. For elderly, in the centre of space have a large bookcase so the people can seat in the sofa which on the few stairs there.

For church member of children and parents, they can come to church form the left side entrance which have a small yard. The first room is a drawing and reading space for children, if you go straight will enter the LEGO playground and pool ball area. Children's parents can go right side there have a seat and looking after they kids.

In my first floor design, I didn't rebuild the existing floor but set up a new one, At the left side have a staircase can go up and enter the cafe have a seat. The right side of the new floor is a small swimming pool and children's climbing net, which connect between ground floor LEGO space and this floor.

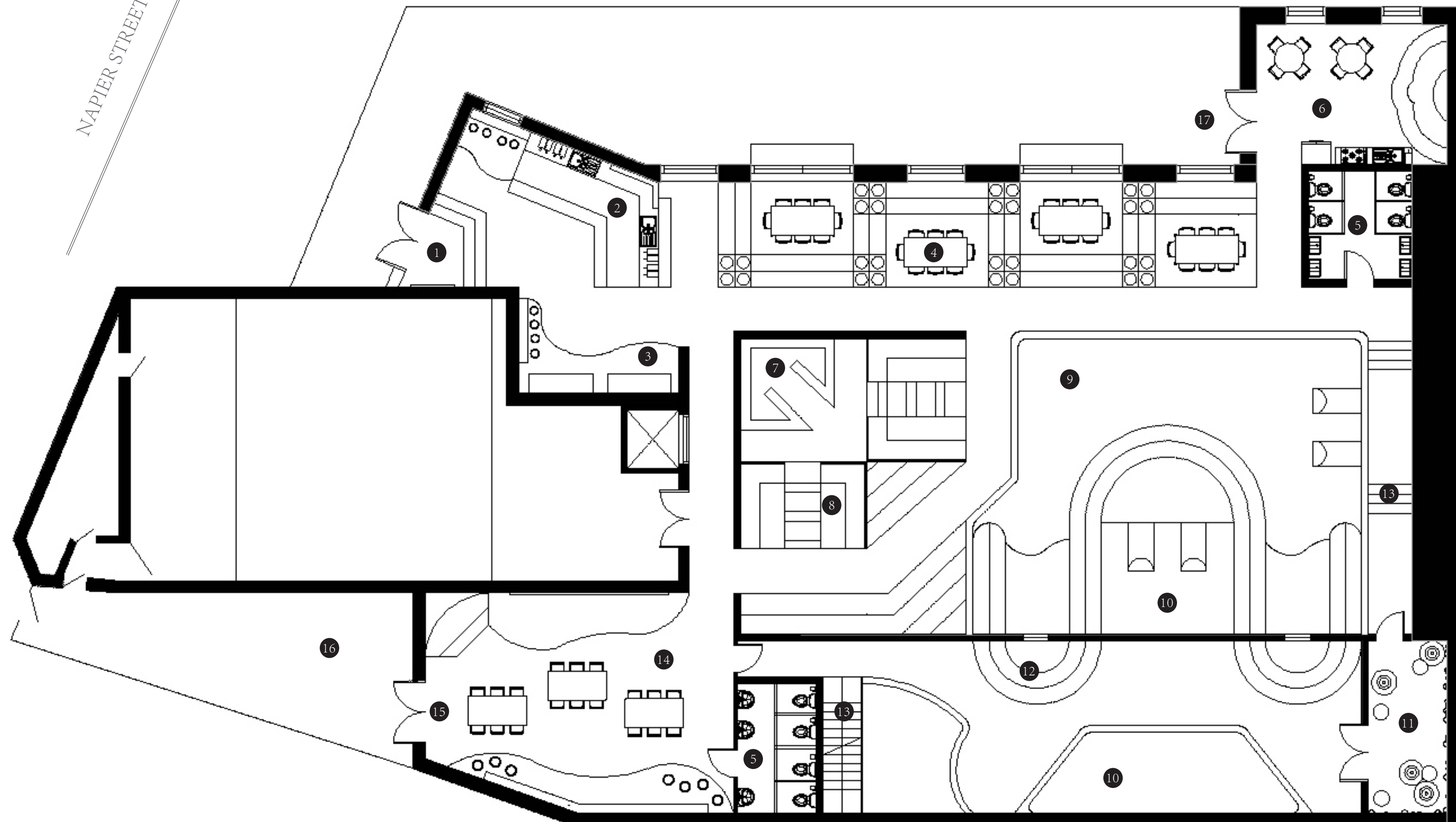




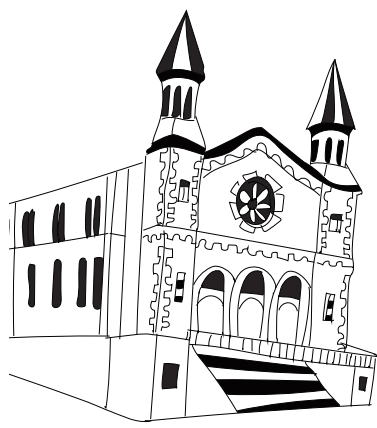
